Surface Inspection Assessments

Technical Surfaces Ltd has compiled the following policy in response to the Coronavirus - Covid 19 outbreak.

- We see no change in our commitment to fulfil your annual pitch inspection and have instigated the **Contactless Entry** policy to provide reassurance when attending site to undertake the inspection.
- For your reassurance, all of our Technical Managers / Consultants are DBS-checked, and this information is available to obtain in advance of attendance.
- On arrival at site, our Technical Manager / Consultant will not enter the premises. They will instead call the nominated contact to gain entry to the surface. Where this cannot be achieved, we politely request that you maintain a distance of 2 metres from our Technical Manager / Consultant.
- We request that the gateways are unlocked on our arrival, to enable unrestricted access for our Technical Manager / Consultant.
- Our Technical Manager / Consultant will ensure that they do not come into close contact with any site personnel.
- Our Technical Manager / Consultant will confine themselves within the pitch for the duration of the inspection.
- The inspection will be undertaken as usual, in line with our normal high standards.
- Sanitech[®] decontaminant solution can be applied by our Technical Manager / Consultant to any gateway contact areas, e.g. locks, handles etc., once the inspection has concluded.
- A full surface condition report will be provided post-completion of the inspection.
- Our Technical Managers / Consultants will try to avoid using your on-site welfare facilities.
- We will utilise our in-house vehicle tracking system and telephone system to monitor our Technical Manager / Consultant whilst on site.
